The information contained in this document is to assist you gain an understanding of what a possible training programme is available. The training programme you finally enrol in will depend on the choice of competencies and specific enterprise requirements identified between the trainee, the employer and Milcom's Field Training Officer

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## 1 Introduction

Certificate III in Technical Security traineeship is an ideal way to develop new staff to work in the Security industry. It completes the training a person has started as a Certificate II in Technical Security through to a fully qualified Technical Security technician

The basis of a traineeship is for the trainee to be learning on the job with some Institution based block training over a period of 12 to 24 months subject to competency assessments. The trainee must be engaged in activities in the workplace that will provide them with the necessary practical skills to support the competency outcomes of the traineeship.

This programme can be tailored to meet the needs of the enterprise; this is achieved by selecting the appropriate competencies. Milcom is happy to discuss the details of the programme to ensure the outcomes your enterprise needs are met.

### 1.1 Competency outcomes

#### Qualification requirements

To achieve recognition at the Certificate III level, the candidate must demonstrate competency in the **ten core units**, plus **four electives** (total fourteen units). Up to two of the required electives may be selected from other qualifications aligned at the Certificate II, III or IV level in this Training Package or from other relevant endorsed

## **1.2 ACMA Registration**

At the completion of the programme the trainee will be able to apply for the ACMA Open Registration subject to the competency assessment

(In NSW To perform Technical Security duties a person must have security licence for other states you must check with local authorities as it varies from state to state)

## **2 Study programme**

It is highly recommended that a person has the certificate II in Technical Security as the minimum before commencing this programme

## **3 Assessment**

Towards the completion of the training programme, an assessor will meet with you to conduct a full assessment to ensure you have covered the material and performed the practical tasks required to fulfil the requirements of the competencies.

## **4 Duration and Fees**

### **4.1 Duration**

The traineeship is designed to run over 18 months. It is possible in certain circumstances to complete the programme earlier subject to approval from the assessors and of State Training Authority.

## **4.2 Fees – Government funded**

Enrolment fee: (It varies from state to state)  
Tuition fee government funded

Payment is required in full prior to commencement of the training programme.

If you withdraw at any time after the first week of the enrolment date, there will be no refund.

## **4.3 Self Funded Fees**

Note, the fees are indicative as the final fees will depend on the RPL and training programme developed between the trainee, the employer and Milcom.

Enrolment fee: \$404  
Tuition fee \$2,475

### **4.3.1 Payment of fees**

Upon commencement of the trainee, Milcom will raise an invoice for:

Enrolment fee of \$404 plus  
Tuition fee of \$1400

This must be paid prior to commencement of any training services

Upon completion of the training services and prior to the final assessment the balance of the tuition fee of \$1075; must be paid before the Certificate can be issued.

If you withdraw within the first four weeks after enrolment and prior to commencing any off the job training, you will be entitled to a full refund of the Tuition fee only. No refund will be made of the enrolment fee.

If you withdraw after the first four weeks and prior to the mid point you will be entitled to a proportional refund of the tuition fees based on the number of weeks into the programme.
